As we begin to move through the 2021 - 2022 school year, we want to communicate to you the update regarding the steps we are taking to provide a safe and educational environment for your children. Attached to this letter is our 2021 – 2022 Mitigation Plan (COVID-19 Safety Plan).

We, at Aguila Elementary School, are:

1. Recommending masks for all on the campus.
2. Hosting multiple vaccination events in the coming weeks to support that option for you and the community at-large. Flyers will be posted on the website and sent home. Please visit <https://www.aguilaschool.org> for more details.
3. Requiring masks on the bus according to the CDC guidelines.
4. Preventing classes from mixing, therefore we will continue eating breakfast in the rooms instead of the café, we are also limiting shared belongings.
5. Continuing to wash/sanitize hands of every student, at least, 5-6 times per day.
6. Continuing to sanitize and disinfect high-touch areas daily and in some instances, 2x daily.
7. Where possible, we will continue to social distance.

Aguila Elementary also appreciates your support in screening your child(ren) for cold and flu symptoms each morning. Please, have your student remain home if they display cold or flu symptoms. In such case, please communicate this to the school office. We will send any student with cold or flu symptoms home.

In closing, we thank you for your patience as we navigate this situation. We are preparing to provide students with the high-quality education you have come to expect from the Aguila Elementary School District. Have a wonderful late summer and early fall!
